On *Next Generation Leader in a Disruptive World*. Panyapiwat Institute of Management Bangkok, Thailand August 25 – September 1, 2019

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

Panyapiwat Institute of Management's Global Leadership Program 2019 offers students the opportunity to undertake a challenging extra-curricular program for a period of eight days, from August 25 to September 1, 2019 (arrival on August 25 & departure on September 1). Centered on the theme "Next Generation Leader in a Disruptive World" the program targets students who are interested to see their personal growth in comprehensive surroundings and how student leadership can impact global challenges and change. Talks and discussions will be conducted in English and cover topics such as: innovative skills, entrepreneurship, peace, career, cultural diversity, intercultural communication, and key difficulties in global societies. This program will provide different extra-curricular activities to engage students in student leadership assignments and provide an avenue to explore Thai culture. Activities will include an introduction to the creativity contest, entrepreneurial engagement, undertaking, group presentation, and sightseeing. The closing ceremony of the program will offer students an opportunity to present their performances, and will receive a certificate for the completion of the program.

STUDENT RECOMMENDATION

Universities will recommend a maximum of 2 students who are active, sincere, and responsible to participate in this program.
