- A letter of recommendation from a lecturer attesting to the applicant's qualifications (the letters must be sent directly to the program director by email)
- A curriculum vitae
- Students for whom English is not their first language must have at least IELTS 6.5 or equivalent qualifications.
- A recent colour photo (scanned and small-sized)
- Any additional supporting material that you may prefer to include in your application

Deadline:

All applicants are required to send their applications via email <u>before Mid-May for Autumn</u> <u>Semester</u> and <u>before Mid-October for Spring Semester</u>. Shortlisted candidates will be informed two weeks after the deadline.
