*Please note that our academic year starts in the Spring semester, so this quota is for Spring 2022 and Fall 2022.

*We consider this quota by taking the imbalance including AY2020 into consideration. However, please do not hesitate to discuss this matter with us because the COVID-19 hugely affected the student mobility in AY2020.

Application period: **1st Nov – 20th Nov 2021 (Japan time)**

Important points:

- **★Each School/Graduate School/Center has different application requirements.** Students must meet all the application requirements of the School/Graduate School/Center they wish to apply to. Please be aware that if your students do not meet the requirements unfortunately, they do not have the eligibility to apply.

- ★When the applicants complete the online application, it is mentioned to submit the evidence to the coordinator so please kindly keep the online application evidence by your side.
- For English taught programmes, English language requirements are only waived if the student's current programme at his/her home institution is taught entirely in English. All other students must submit the required English language test score. Please refer to each School/Graduate School's requirements for the kinds of score accepted, and advise your students to take necessary tests in advance. Similarly, students who wish to study on a Japanese taught programme must submit a JLPT certificate.
- In principle, students can only take courses from the School/Graduate School/Center they apply to. Therefore, students must carefully check the course list when choosing which School/Graduate School/Center to apply to.
- The Science and Engineering Schools are divided into Majors, and students can only take courses from the Major they apply to. Please be aware that the choices of English courses available to undergraduate exchange students are quite limited, and undergraduate exchange students cannot take any courses related to lab work/experiments.
- Please make sure students upload the grading scale/explanation of grading criteria with their transcripts, since this is often forgotten.
- Please make sure that the Official Certificate of Enrollment includes all the necessary information. Please also advise your students to write the same graduation date on their application forms as schedule on the Certificate of Enrollment.
- If a student has taken a leave of absence due to military service or other reason, please make sure he/she explains this on a separate sheet and upload it together with the other documents.

Important changes:

- Graduate School of International Culture and Communication Studies (GSICCS)

Submission of the English language proficiency test score (TOEFL, IELTS or TOEIC) is mandatory for all GSICCS applicants. A letter from the home institution is not considered as sufficient proof of English proficiency.

Starting from Spring 2022 admission, exchange students who apply for GSICCS are not required to select supervisors and register in Direct Research.
